Is research based.

Is a hands-on activity using manipulative letter tiles to foster word consciousness. The goal is to understand how our alphabetic system works. It includes decoding and analogy, supporting spelling patterns; the brain is a pattern-seeking device!

- -Emphasis on letter-sound relationships and word patterns: Applications of phonics as sounds are labeled with symbols.
- -Starts with specific letters needed to make many words including the ending result of challenge word.
- -Assists in spelling / proper letter sequence coordinating with sounds of words as well as syllabication.
- -Phonemic awareness development with manipulation of phonemes to create new words by changing letters or arrangement of letters.
- -Awareness and application of vowel or consonant combinations within words and sounds expected.
 - -Awareness of homophones and compound words.
 - -Awareness of words that are "rule breakers".
 - -Supplements reading and expands vocabulary.
