Ways to Learn My ABC's!

READ*READ*READ*!

Make words with Alpha-Bits cereal. Make flashcards from index cards and play Concentration. Trace letters in cornmeal, dry Jell-O, or pudding. Trace letters in colored hair gel in a zip-locked bag. Walmart has laminated placemats with letters. Fill dry water bottle with rice and letters then shake & find. Play "Eye-Spy" around the house with magnifying glasses. String letters found at Hobby Lobby or sort by colors. Alphabet cookie cutters.....bake and eat! Put foam stick-on letters on juice lids. Write letters on milk lids with permanent marker. Collect environmental print to identify letters. Cut letters from textured wallpaper or sandpaper. Put magnetic letters on cookie sheets. Write letters on the sidewalk with chalk. Write letters on the sidewalk with an old paintbrush & water. Find and cut out letters in magazines. Go fishing for letters with a magnet- paperclips can be the hooks. Make letters out of Playdough- store bought or homemade. Bend letters into shape with pipe cleaners. Go Fish card game. Make your own or visit Walmart. Puzzles, Scrabble, Alphabet Bingo. Sponge letters using washable paint or Bingo markers. Plastic canvas under paper makes texture for letters. Glue beans or rice on large letter outlines. Velcro letters onto paint sticks to add/remove letters. Swat letters around the house with a clean fly swatter. Make letters from pretzel sticks and mini marshmallows. White boards and erasable markers. Point out letters on street and highway signs & stores. Make letters with your body. Spell out letters with M&M's candies. Draw letters in the sand if you go to the beach. Write letter with white crayons onto black paper. Label things in your child's room so they see letters go together to make words.
