Grab and Go Second Chance Breakfast - CAC will begin offering a grab and go second chance breakfast on Tuesday, September 3rd. This opportunity will be available between 8:45 and 9:00 a.m. The breakfast will include one entrée, fruit, juice, and milk which students will pick-up and take to their classroom to eat. Students may choose to eat the normal breakfast which will include two entrées and cereal options that are served beginning at 7:20 a.m. or the second chance option but cannot have both breakfasts. If your student qualifies for free meals this breakfast is also free. The reduced price is \$0.30 and the full-pay breakfast is \$1.65. The Grab and Go menu is available on the district website with the breakfast and lunch menus.

<u>Attendance Race</u> - The grade levels at CAC are having a quarterly attendance race. The grade level with the highest percentage of students in attendance for the quarter will win a reward of some kind which is yet to be determined.
