Activities Update – Well, we are trying to get the track season underway. The first meet of the year was scheduled for yesterday at Central Heights. Our first home track meet was scheduled for this Friday, beginning at 2:00 at Santa Fe Trail High School. FBLA State Conference – Mrs. Gretta Hug and Mrs. Ashley Michaelis, sponsors of our FBLA chapter recently took our students to two competitions. The regional contest was held in Emporia on the campus of ESU. At that site several students qualified for the state contests held in Topeka. Our students received 31 top-ten places at that competition. Of those, eight of our students had multiple awards, with a total of 19 students earning top-ten finishes. Of the eight categories, our students placed first in five of them. We are proud of the students and coaches for these achievements. I am grateful that the BOE allowed us to add FBLA to our programming at the junior high. Hopefully, this is experience that will allow our students to excel at the high school level in the future.

State Assessments – The state assessments are well underway. Mrs. Hamit has been very busy directing testing traffic here as well as at OAC and SFTHS. As the district test coordinator, it falls on her to keep things on schedule and in working order. She does it masterfully. We hope to complete the testing in the next two weeks. I am hopeful the students are taking the assessments seriously, as the district does make curriculum and instructional changes based on the results of any of our testing programs.

 8^{th} Grade Conferences – Mrs. Hamit, Mrs. Mead, and I want to thank all the eighth grade students and parents for coming in for the high school transition conferences. Each year the three of us meet with each individually in an effort to give some high school preparation/knowledge and to review the ACT/Aspire Test results from the fall. Selecting classes for freshman year is an important activity, and these meetings give us the chance to help facilitate that. If any of you have feedback for us that would make these conferences better for you, please let us know. We want them to be productive and helpful, and to know that the eighth graders are ready for their movement to the high school. And if you asked any questions at those meetings that have not been answered, please remind us. I will do my best to get the answers to you with immediacy.

One More Note from Mr. Flax – Every year for at least the last three rumors have flown around that I am retiring. And every year as parents ask me about that rumor, I say I will let you know myself when that is going to happen. So this is my time to tell you that I will not be here next year.
