

LEAP Law Early Admission Program

The Law Early Admission Program (LEAP) allows Washburn University undergraduates to apply for acceptance into Washburn Law during what would have been their last semester of undergraduate work. The program allows for the last semester of undergraduate work (elective credits) to be satisfied by the successful completion of the first semester of law school.

LEAP was primarily designed for incoming freshmen as it requires careful consultation with an advisor to make the credits work properly. However, theoretically, any enrolled Washburn student may apply for entry into LEAP if they achieve the credit requirements. All applicants must complete a law school application and take the LSAT.

Admission Requirements

- An ACT score in the top quartile (28 or higher)
- A high school GPA of 3.5 on a 4 point scale
- An application and an acceptance decision by the prelaw coordinator
- An LSAT score
- A separate application to Washburn Law

LEAP Completion Requirements

- Maintain a 3.0 GPA
- Take the free diagnostic LSAT each semester
- Complete all requirements for graduation (except for the remaining semester to be completed with law school credits)
