FastBridge Assessments

What is FastBridge?

FastBridge is a research-based screener assessment that helps teachers identify students' learning needs early in the school year. It includes brief, reliable assessments in reading and math that are given three times throughout the year. The data from FastBridge helps our teachers tailor instruction to meet the individual needs of each student, ensuring that every child receives the support they need to succeed.
