Thank You - Thank you so much for supporting your student through the Red Wheel Fund Raiser process. Collectively the students sold 972 items!! Fall Sports - Saturday, September 29th wraps up the 2018 JH volleyball season with league tournament at Burlington. All teams have had some success throughout the season. The football teams will have also had numerous wins with three games yet to play in October before their season comes to an end. Each cross country runner has continued to improve their finish times and have two meets remaining in this season. Girls basketball practice will begin on October 2nd and wrestling practice on October 15th.
