Title: District Social Worker

Qualifications:

- 1. Meets State Social Worker licensing regulations
- 2. Masters level in Social Work or higher
- 3. Experience in public schools preferred

Reports to: Superintendent and Director of Curriculum and Instruction

Job Goal: To work effectively with students, parents and district staff to facilitate student school success.

Performance Responsibilities:

1. General Responsibilities

- a. The social worker is responsible for the assessment of need and delivery of
 intervention services to students and families with a primary focus on grades 4-12.
 Grades Pre K-3 will be on a case by case basis and only high needs cases.
- b. Coordinates appropriate community resources for students and families.

2. Services to Families

- a. Provide short-term counseling interventions and consultation services to families whose student is experiencing difficulties adjusting to other children or school.
- b. Provide resources to families with needs in relation to school.
- c. Provide assistance to families and school during the adjustment period when a child is returning to the community.
- d. Facilitate communication between home and school.

3. Services to Children

- a. Provide short-term counseling (either individually or in groups) to children who have difficulties adjusting to other children or school.
- b. Provide short-term counseling (either individually or in groups) who are experiencing learning or behavioral problems.
- c. Provide support to children in special education programs.
- d. Help students attain an optimum level of personal and social adjustment.

4. Services to School Personnel

- a. Assist in cases of child abuse, truancy, pregnancy and crisis.
- b. Serve as a member of the multi-disciplinary team responsible for comprehensive evaluations.
- c. Collaborate with and support teachers and school administration in their efforts to understand and utilize the uniqueness of each child's heritage.

- d. Attend faculty meetings and school committee meeting as requested.
- e. Provide in-service meetings to school personnel on basic needs of children and families, family systems, utilization of community resources and other pertinent topics.
- f. Works cooperatively with the Three Lakes Special Education Cooperative to monitor district students with Individualized Education Plans.

5. Service within and for communities

- a. Serve as one of the liaisons with community agencies, facilitating communication between school and community.
- b. Assist in developing community awareness of needs of all children, including those with exceptional needs.
- c. Refer children, parents, or families to community agencies as needed.
- d. Maintain follow-up of children being seen by another community agency as requested.
- e. Develop Trauma Response partnership with schools, community and families.

Performance of this job will be evaluated by the Superintendent in accordance with provisions of the Boards policy of Evaluation of Teachers.
