### What's happening in the Curriculum Department?

The Math Adoption Team (MAT-H) has met 3 times now to work on the process and procedures for curriculum alignment and adoption for K-5 mathematics. The following areas of research and production have begun.

- 1. Timeline and Tasks for Committee Work
- 2. Grade Level feedback survey and data analysis
- 3. Training on the Power Standards Model
- 4. Vertical Grade Level Collaboration
- 5. Unwrapping State Standards
- 6. Alignment comparison to KSDE focus documents for mathematics

<u>Winter Benchmarking</u> will take place before the winter break for K-8<sup>th</sup> Grade and after break for 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade. These assessments will allow for teachers to evaluate student growth and support decision maing for interventions that students may need. This will also help teachers drive their core instruction to fill learning gaps.

### Social and Emotional Learning

Now more than ever, it is crucial that we are meeting the needs of the whole child. Schools not only provide a place for academics but a place for socialization, managing emotions, opportunities to learn from others, and a place to gain a sense of purpose and belonging. The amount of time spent in school each day illustrates our need to provide opportunities for students to grow in these areas of their life. USD 434 staff is moving forward with their professional development in this area and learning new strategies to support students. Supporting students and families with these areas is imperative for academic growth

### **Individual Plans of Study**

Individual plans of study (IPS) are a crucial component to student growth and preparation for post-secondary life. Students are developing their goals and process for the 2021-2022 school year as a guide to their learning and preparation for the future. They are taking interest inventories and setting goals based on their skills and interests. Teacher will be mentoring student about this data and supporting them in their action steps to meet their goals. Students will also create a digital portfolio to support this process that will also allow for teachers to interact with student work over time.
