## **ART EVENTS**

The Pioneer League Art Competition Mythological Madness April 27th, 2022. We are really excited this year because it is our first time hosting. This is a jampacked all-day event with an Exhibition (25 art pieces each from 7 districts compete for Best in Show), Drawing Competition (teams have 2 ½ hrs to complete their drawing design from start to finish), and Sculpting Competition (teams have 2 ½ hrs to complete their sculpture from start to finish). The exhibition is judged while the teams are creating. Then while teams eat lunch their creations for the day are ranked. Our judges this year are Associate Professor of Art, Brianne Fulton Miller from Ottawa University, and Russell Horton, Assistant Professor of Art, from Baker University.

**2022 Congressional Art Competition**. This contest is a special and unique chance to recognize and encourage the artistic talent in our district. This nationwide high school art competition is sponsored each spring by members of the U.S. House of Representatives Congressional Art Caucus. The winning student from each Congressional District across the nation will receive two airline tickets to see the artwork in the U.S. Capitol Building in Washington, D.C., and have the opportunity to visit with their Members of Congress. The competition is now open, and all the artwork must be submitted to our Topeka or Pittsburg office by **Friday, April 29 at 5:00 pm**. Our team would be more than happy to personally pick up all submissions from your school. An Art Advisory Committee from Kansas' Second District will judge the submitted artwork. Our office will announce the winners of the competition on Monday, May 9th.

# Athletics and Activities at Santa Fe Trail High School

# **SFTHS Spring Sports**

Spring sports are off and running. As usual, weather has posed some challenges with events as well as practices. Several high school students are participating, as baseball has 21 players, and softball 22. Golf has 15 and track has 24 girls and 24 boys.

#### Baseball

Baseball has been able to get all scheduled games in so far. The team is off to a great start posting a 5-1, getting 2 wins over Prairie View and West Franklin, and went 1-1 vs Royal Valley. Wellsville is the host school for Regionals May 16th and 18th. The top 4 seeds of the 8-team regional will host on May 16th. On May 18th, the semi-finals and final game will be at Wellsville. The winner will play in Manhattan at the KSU stadium on May 26-27.

### Softball

Softball has also been able to get in 6 games. The girls are 2-4, with a sweep over West Franklin, and losing both games to Prairie View and Rossville. Regionals is at West Franklin, with games set for May 16 and 18. The number 1 and 2 seed will host the first two rounds (quarters and semi-finals), with the championship game being played at West Franklin on May 18. The winner will play in Manhattan at the Twin Oaks Complex.

## Boys Golf

SFT missed their first tournament because of weather, but opened on April 5th at the Burlington Invitational. The returning State Champs won the tournament by 50 strokes! SFT is the 3A Regional host, with the tournament being held at Lamont Hill on May 16th. The top 2 teams, and the next 5 lowest scores will compete in Salina at the 3A state tournament on May 23-24th.

#### Track & Field

The Santa Fe Trail track team saw their first action on Thursday, March 31st when they traveled to Silver Lake. At this track meet, both the varsity and junior varsity competed. Team results were: Varsity Girls 3rd Place, Junior Varsity Boys 2nd Place. The team has also competed at Osage City, where both the boys and girls took 3rd place overall. Santa Fe Trail will participate in the 3A Regional Track Meet hosted by Royal Valley High School on Friday, May 20<sup>th</sup>.
