FastBridge Winter Scores Celebrations

- 2nd - 12th students in the **Reading** Assessment had an **INCREASE of 7%** district wide! In the fall, 50% of students' scored in college pathway and low risk (Tier 1), and winter scores increased to 57% of our students in Tier 1.
- 2nd - 12th students in the **Math** Assessment had an **INCREASE of 4%** district wide! In the fall, 56% of students scored in college pathway & low risk (Tier 1), and winter scores increased to 60% of our students in Tier 1.
- 2nd - 12th grade students had a **DECREASE of both some risk (Tier 2) and high risk (Tier 3) scores in both reading and math**; meaning that we moved more students out of these Tier 2 and Tier 3 levels and into the college pathway and low risk levels (Tier 1).
- First grade students **INCREASED** the number of students in the college pathway and low risk Tier 1 for **reading by 8%**, going from fall of 19% students in Tier 1 to 27%!
- First grade students **INCREASED** the number of students in the college pathway and low risk Tier 1 for **math by 10%**, going from 55% students in Tier 1 to 65%!
- Second grade had **tremendous growth** in both **reading and math!! 31% in Tier 1 to 44% in reading and 38% in Tier 1 to 62% in math!**
- Seventh grade students **INCREASED** the number of students in **Tier 1 from 50% to 61% in Reading!**
- Eighth grade students **INCREASED** the number of students in **Tier 1 from 52% to 60% in Math!**
- Tenth grade students **INCREASED** the number of students in **Tier 1 from 64% to 72% in Reading!**
- Eleventh grade students **INCREASED** the number of students in **Tier 1 from 57% to 64% in Math!!!**
