BOE Goal 5: Budget and Facilities

The preschool is a high priority when considering our budget planning. In the past 6 years we have developed a universal preschool model that welcomes all 3 and 4-year-old district students to attend half day sessions of school. Our preschool operates with very little revenue but have continued to ensure free or low-cost services to our families. We also transport students, serve snacks, provide curriculum and instruction, and pay for various personnel to meet the needs of our students and facility needs. The expenses to run this program and maintain the building are a great consideration for this BOE goal as it pertains to funding programming and capital outlay planning. We will continue to keep our preschool operations a high priority in our action planning as we support our students in early childhood and future Kindergarten Readiness. We are very proud of the preschool USD 434 has created for our students.
