## FRIENDLY REMINDERS

### Arrival and Dismissal Procedures

To ensure a safe and efficient traffic flow, please follow these guidelines:

- Arrival: Enter the south parking lot exclusively from Scranton Avenue and 2nd Street.
- Prohibited Entry Points:
  - Do not enter through the marked gates.
  - Do not park in the lot on S. Burlingame Avenue. This area must remain clear for buses.
- Employee Parking:
  - Parking in front of the building is reserved for employees only.
- No Parking Zones:
  - There is no parking permitted on 2nd Street either behind or in front of the buses. This area must stay clear for bus access.
