














- According to most experts, children under the age of 2 should have no screen time, while children between 2 and 5 years old should be limited to a maximum of one hour of screen time per day, and children 6 and older should not exceed two hours of recreational screen time per day.
- Key Points to Remember
 - Educational Content: For young children, prioritize
 educational programming when screen time is allowed.
 - Co-Viewing: Parents should actively engage with their children while watching screens.
 - Screen-Free Time: Encourage other activities like outdoor play and social interaction.
 - Bedtime routine: Avoid screens for at least 30 minutes
 before bedtime.
