AGES AND STAGES QUESTIONNAIRE REQUIRED SCREENER



Families of Santa Fe Trail 2025-2026 PreK students Today we are sharing a link containing two assessments, which are simple
questionnaire screeners to identify developmental and social-emotional
strengths and areas that may need support for your child. These
questionnaires provide a quick check of your child and the information will
remain confidential. Your answers will help us get to know your child better
and how we can support him or her in the classroom. The ASQ Screener is a
state mandated assessment for all PreK and Kindergarten students to
complete in the state of Kansas. Families will need to complete the screener
based on typical behavior / development they see for their child.

Tips:

If activities are involved in the questionnaire, make it a game that's fun for you and your child.

Make sure your child is well rested and fed before trying any activities and try the activity before marking a response.

Answer questions based on usual behavior - not how the child acts when sick, very tired, or hungry. For example, while your child may become clingy when ill, she is usually independent and outgoing.
